Notes on registering:

- The number of Scouts per unit may be limited to 5 or fewer if there is an over registration that occurs. Please list scouts in priority order on reg. form
- All Scouts must be pre-registered – NO WALK-INS WILL BE ALLOWED  
Each unit must have a leader present for the entire session.
