BSA uniforms are required for the Sunday youth program and Class B uniforms are encouraged for the rest of the weekend. Either the BSA Field Uniform (sometimes referred to as "Class A", including Scout shorts or long trousers, Scout uniform shirts, Venturing shirts, Scout socks) or the BSA Activity Uniform (sometimes referred to as "Class B": Scout shorts or pants with Scouting golf or t-shirts) may be worn at camping school.

Dormitory style housing with metal bunk beds with mattresses will be provided in either indoor cabin. If you prefer, bring your tent and enjoy the quiet peaceful surroundings.

Bedding and linens will not be provided, so please plan to bring your sleeping bag, or bedding with you.
