

Cub Launch – Frequently Asked Questions

What is Cub Launch? It is an event for new Cub Scouts AND existing Cub Scouts, and their families. It showcases the best of Cub Scout's activities including BB guns, archery, slingshots, fishing, games, STEM activities, and much more! Will all the locations have the same activities? No. Unfortunately not all locations are equipped to offer the same exact program. Most (if not all) will offer shooting sports, STEM, a craft, and a chance to learn more about the bobcat badge. Beaumont Scout Reservation's Cub Launch will offer the most activities and can offer overnight camping accommodations if you are coming from far away.

How much is it? \$10 per scout and sibling

How old must the siblings be to participate? Any sibling is welcome to attend, any age! However, to participate, the sibling must be register and paid for. Siblings younger than 6 will have the chance to do certain program areas but others, such as shooting sports, will be off limits due to age restrictions.

Do we register adults for this event? No. Just children, scouts and siblings.

Can grandma and grandpa come to the event? Yes! Invite your neighbors too! This event is a chance to show the community who scouters are and the fun activities we do!

Is this an event I can drop my child(ren) off at? No. This is a family/pack event and all children must be accompanied by a guardian or a unit leader.

What do we receive with registration? Children get the chance to participate in activities and a commemorative patch.

Is this event Rain or Shine? YES! This event will occur rain or shine—in fact the rain makes it more fun! Bring your rain gear and a smile.

What should we bring? The family! And close toe-ed shoes, water bottles, snacks or lunch, rain gear, bug spray, sunscreen, and lots of excitement!

Will lunch be provided? At the Beaumont location, there will be a trading post where lunch is available for purchase. Lunch items range from \$2 to \$4 per item. There will be hotdogs, hamburgers, pizza, chips, soda and water available.

Will there be a trading post? Yes! There will be a small trading post available at each location. Beaumont will offer a larger trading post. Scout gear ranges from \$2 to \$20 an item, featuring cool scout gadgets and t-shirts!
