



There has never been a better time to be involved with Scouting

- In the past year, we have recognized **61,353 new Eagle Scouts**, all of whom completed at least 21 merit badges, made significant contributions to their local communities and embody the Scout Oath and Law.
- The BSA's members and volunteers provided **13 million hours of service** to communities across the country last year.
- Scouts earned more than **1.7 million merit badges** in 2019, introducing them to a spectrum of hobbies, careers, and life skills.
- In 2019, nearly **900,000 Scouts** attended our day camps and summer camps across the country.
- Since 2017, the BSA has welcomed more than **160,000 girls** into Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA.
- More than **40,000 participants** from more than **150 countries** attended the World Scout Jamboree.
- Throughout our history, **6,534 Scouts** have received one of three national-level lifesaving awards, recognizing extraordinary heroism and skill in saving or attempting to save life.
