

## MERIT BADGE SKILL CENTER Citizenship in the Nation, St. Louis MO Tuesday, July 1, 2025

**Locations:** Old Courthouse at the Gateway Arch National Park AND Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse

**Times:** Arrive at the Old Courthouse at 8:30 a.m. for check-in. Program begins at 9:00 a.m. The group will walk to the Eagleton Courthouse at 10:00 a.m., and be dismissed from there at 4:30 pm.



Learn what it means to be a citizen of the United States by participating in a variety of sessions, touring a site that is on the National Register of Historic Places, and touring a federal facility. The program begins at the Historic Old Courthouse and ends at the Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse. Presenters will be from both facilities and will include a federal judge. The workshop is free, but reservations are required, and space is limited.

## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS REGISTRATION HAS CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS:

- Minimum age requirement: Scouts MUST have reached 13<sup>th</sup> birthday by July 1.
- Registrations will be taken on a first come, first served basis, beginning at 7:00 A.M. on Monday, April 28.
- Once the program is full, additional names will be added to a waiting list.
- Registrations will only be taken through the online form. Phone registrations will not be taken.
- You may register multiple Scouts, but you MUST complete a new form for each Scout. Spots will not be held for any Scouts with missing information.
- Collect the following information for EACH Scout before attempting to complete the form(s). Scouts will not be considered registered if information is missing.
  - Parent Name
  - Parent Email Address
  - Parent Phone Number
  - Scout Name
  - Troop # and District
  - Age Scout will be on July 1
  - Allergies/special needs/other health concerns
  - Name of parent attending (optional)
  - Name and cell # of an emergency contact who is NOT attending the program

To Bring: Scouts should bring a pencil, a signed Merit Badge Card, completed pre-requisite activities, signed photo form, a lunch, and a water bottle. A copy of the Merit Badge Pamphlet is recommended.
