Square Knots

Den Leader Training Award

This award recognizes den leaders who have completed training, tenure, and performance requirements. It is available for Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and Webelos den leaders and can be earned in each



Scouter's Training Award

This award can be presented to registered who have two years' tenure in the unit and have completed position-specific training and other performance requirements designed to encourage and recognize those who give of their resources to make the unit successful.




Cubmaster's/Scoutmaster's Key

This award is for Cub Scout adult leaders with three years' tenure—including at least two years as Cubmaster—who have completed training and other performance requirements. The Cubmaster's Key is also a great way to incorporate a succession plan for Cubmaster.

International Scouter's Award

To recognize adult volunteers who promote international Scouting on all levels who in turn help broaden the perspectives of Scouting.




ServiceStars
