Individual Summer Experiences

The Greater St. Louis Area Council offers several programs that Scouts can attend on their own each summer. For 2024, Scouts can choose from the following adventures!

- S-F Ranger Program Spend a week backpacking and exploring the 5,200 acre S-F Scout Ranch. Take part in unique activities at locations around the ranch very few Scouts ever get to see. For Scouts BSA & Venturers aged 14 and above and adults.
- Horse Camp Participants spend a week at an intermediate riding camp cantering around Beaumont Scout Reservation and learning more about horses. Trail Rides, competitions, games, and more are just some of the activities to participate in. All campers must be at least 14 years old to participate.
- STEM and Skilled Trades Camp Combined for 2024, the STEM and Skilled Trades Camp will feature merit badge opportunities with experts in STEM-based and Skilled Trades areas. All Scouts BSA members are encouraged to attend this unique experience at Beaumont Scout Reservation.

Leadership is provided for all of these experiences, so Scouts sign-up on their own and do not need to have their Troop attend.
