What is Day Camp?

Day Camps operate during the day time approximately 9am-4pm or in the evening 5:30PM to 8:30PM.

Who: Girls and boys, Scouts & non-Scouts, 1st - 5th grades

The Experience: The 2023 Day Camp Theme is Where the Wild Scouts Are – a focus on outdoor wilderness survival skills, animals, and all of the summer classics

Overnight summer camps are why a Scout joins the BSA! These camps range from 1 - 4 nights, are held at Scout properties, and are a safe, educational, and fun experience for all Scout ages and ranks.

The Experience:

- Arrive at camp, receive camp orientation and set up campsite
- Activities: Nature hikes, swimming (instructional and free swim), shooting sports (bb guns, archery), science experiments, games, outdoor skills, wilderness survival, outdoor cooking, etc.
- Meals are served in a dining hall
- Camp Staff will put on a campfire program the first night lots of laughter, singing and skits!

Camp Lewallen

Camp Lewallen is nestled in the Ozark Plateau in the shadow of Mt. Logan. Rhodes France Scout Reservation




One of four camps on the 5,200+ acre S-F Scout Ranch, Swift High Adventure Base is the region's premier Venturing Summer Camp facility. Summer camps at Swift are also open to Explorer Posts and older Scout Patrols. Individuals (provisional) are also welcome to attend!

The Ranch's 270+ acre Nims Lake serves as the focal point for water skiing, sailing, fishing, canoeing, swimming, water tubing, sun bathing, and kayaking. One of the highlights of the lake is our very own water park, Huck's Cove. Huck's Cove features two waterslides, rope swings, zip line, inflatables, & more!

Ranger Program

S-F Scout Ranch

The Ranger Program is a one-of-a-kind back-country adventure. Scouts spend the week backpacking to various outpost campsites across the 5,200 acre S-F Scout Ranch. Activities can include blacksmithing, challenge courses, wilderness survival skills practice, black powder rifle shooting, fishing, canoeing across the 270 acre Nim's Lake, and more!

This program is designed for Scouts age 14 or older, or in their 4th summer of camp. The Ranger Program is also a great preparation opportunity for a trek at Philmont Scout Ranch.

STEM Week is an extraordinary experience for Scouts full of many STEM based merit badges and over-the-top activities. Scouts will attend one merit badge (over to 40 to choose from!) or one NOVA activity class each day and may have the opportunity to work on other badges in the evening. Afternoon and evenings will include other fun STEM programs and exhibits to experience (drones, 3D printing, things that go boom... you get the idea). If you want more in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics, this is the week to be out at camp!

National Youth Leadership Training


