Webelos & Arrow of Light Camporee Programming

WEBELOS /Arrow of Light Scouts (4th and 5th Grade) who attend will earn a required adventure. If a Scout attends three camporees, they will complete three of the six required adventures:

- Fall 2023 (October 13 15) Castaway
- Spring 2024 Into the Woods
- Fall 2024 Outdoor Adventurer

Remember

- Webelos and Arrow of Light groups must register and camp with a Scouts BSA Troop to attend. This design enables youth to learn about different troops and become familiar with the Patrol method.
- All adults attending camporee MUST be currently registered with BSA per Youth Protection Camping Policy, see below.

Youth Protection Camping Updates - Effective September 1

- All adults staying overnight in connection with a Scouting activity must be currently registered as an adult volunteer or an adult program participant.
- Cub Scout Programs Overnight Exception:

These apply to any Pack/Cub Scouts Campouts or Call of the Wild. For District Camporee, all adults must be registered.

- Cub Scout's parents or legal guardians taking part in an overnight Cub Scout program with their own child or legal ward are not required to register as leaders. However, they must review must review the "How to Protect your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent's Guide"
- o In addition, the parent or legal guardian must be accompanied by a registered leader at any time they are with youth members other than their own child/ward.
- o All other overnight adults must be currently registered in an adult fee required position.
