Instructions

- 1. Merit Badge Counselors are required to be registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
 - If you are not currently registered, you must request and complete a BSA Adult Leader registration form. It may be obtained from any Council Service Center.
 - A background check is part of this process. There is a non-member fee of \$25.00.
 - The counselor position will be listed as a multiple position for members.
- 2. A maximum of four merit badges is permitted per counselor.
- 3. You must be at least 18 years of age or older.
- 4. Maintain current Youth Protection Training.
- 5. When applying for the Citizenship in Society badge, complete DEI training at my.scouting.org and complete the agreement form. More information is available on STLBSA.org/advancement-awards/
- 6. Merit Badge Counselor Training is available at my.scouting. In Scouts BSA section.
- 7. Be specific in stating your qualifications. If you need more space, please use an extra sheet of paper.
- 8. The Merit Badge Counselor Directory is located on the STLBSA.org website. All merit badge counselors will be displayed on the website. Merit Badge Counselors are also listed in Scoutbook.
- 9. Application and Approval Process
 - o Complete the paper application and send to the council office or complete the online application.
 - o Secure the District Advancement Chairman's and/or the District Executive's approval.
 - o Update the Merit Badge Counselor Directory and Scoutbook.
 - Provide an email notification to the counselor.
- 10. Your Merit Badge Counselor number is the same as your membership number.
- 11. Annual renewal is required. You will be sent an email with the directions annually from National.
- 12. Nova Counselor should apply with a BSA Adult Application and Supernova Mentor requires a Supernova Mentor Application. See the STEM page at https://stlbsa.org/stem-unit/ for more information. These will be included in the annual renewal process and the non-member fee applies.
