Duty to God Moment

Celebrating Scout Jumu'ah, Scout Sabbath and Scout Sunday in 2024



Baden-Powell suggests in his guide book for scoutmasters, "It is expected that every Scout shall belong to some religious institution, and attend its services". It is fitting, then, that religious organizations host a celebration in conjunction with the anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America in February to recognize a Scout's Duty to God. While the exact dates for these celebrations vary by group, they are wonderful opportunities for Scouts to share with their faith communities, the 12th point of the Scout Law -- that a Scout is Reverent. (For Muslim youth, Scout Jumu'ah is the first Friday following February 8. In 2023, Scout Sabbath was celebrated on February 10 and 11. Many Christian scouts celebrate Scout Sunday on the Sunday that falls before February 8.)

For some, these celebrations include extensive involvement by Scouts in the planning and/or participation in a worship service. Scouts could also attend a service in full uniform and perhaps be recognized by their community with any religious awards they have earned. The key is to coordinate with the leaders of the religious community to create an event that is in harmony with its customs. Scouts can also use these occasions to express their appreciation, a formal "thank you" for the support provided by their faith community, especially when it is the unit's chartering organization.

It is not too early to start planning your Scout Sunday celebration now. February will be here before you know it!


