- Safety glasses, if you have them. If not, they will be provided.
- **Closed toed shoes, pants that extend to the ankle and shirt sleeves that extend to the wrist are required.** Due to the nature of the activities, Scouts not properly attired will be sent home. NO EXCEPTIONS.
