DUTY TO GOD MOMENT





Paraphrasing Lord Baden Powell, he once said that we should teach Scouts not just how to make a living, but rather how to **live**.

Part of living a balanced life is attending to our spiritual needs.

A unit Chaplain and a Chaplain Aide can be wonderful resources for helping Scouts be more attentive to their spiritual well-being.

A chaplain may be an adult committee member or a religious leader from a faith-based organization, including the unit's chartering organization.

If the unit is not chartered by a religious institution, a chaplain can be chosen from local institutions who can meet the spiritual needs of your unit's members.

The main role of the chaplain is to provide a spiritual element for unit activities with the help of a chaplain aide. They can offer group counseling in times of grief, and times of trouble. They can also advise individuals when problems or conflicts arise. For the unit, they can encourage prayers at meals. When the unit is planning a week-end outing, they can offer and assist with a youth-led non-denominational worship service.

The chaplain is in an ideal position to promote the religious emblems program and encourage Scouts to complete the requirements for the emblem of their faith.

Another opportunity is the religious observance held during Scout Week in February. Other opportunities for spiritual growth can be developed in conjunction with the youth leaders and the unit committee.

Duty to God doesn't happen by accident. Leadership in the key roles of Chaplain and Chaplain Aide can help a unit participate more fully in a Scout's Duty to God.


