General Information

If your Instructor card for Challenge Course or Rock Climbing is expired or about to expire you may get re-certified for one or both programs on one Sunday. Easy to do – pay a \$5 fee, please register on-line or bring to training – bring check or exact \$. The recertification is rather simple; we give you a pile of gear and ask you to set up a climb, rappel, or high course descent. It is much like a merit badge review. We review climbing or course operation and tell you about any changes in procedures or equipment.

Your card does not need to expire before being re-certified. If your card has already expired, you can also be re-certified. If you were never certified for one of the programs, you can't be recertified.

Options on Requalification – NEW SCHEDULE:

- Challenge Course Start at **8am** (8am-1pm)
- Challenge, Tower & Climbing Start at **8am** (8am-3pm)
- Tower Climbing (for Tower-Only instructors) Start at **10am** (10am-noon)
- Rock Climbing Start at 11:30am (11:30am-3pm)
- Giant City Climbing Skill Segment (Optional) Start at 3pm (3-4:30pm)

Please arrive 15 minutes before your session to check in. If you have questions, reach out <u>before</u> the requalification day you plan to attend.

Additional Note for Challenge Course Instructors

Anyone desiring to re-qualify as an Instructor for the High Course must ascend a caving ladder. If you can no longer qualify by climbing the ladder you will be able to qualify as a Low Course Instructor. We took this action to ensure that High Course Instructors will be able to affect a rescue in the High Course at either of the courses.


