Responsibilities:

2. Keep the Council Table Host Chair regularly informed of progress towards goals as well as anticipated changes
3. Recruit and cultivate table hosts that have the ability to give \$500+ and to ask others to do the same.
4. Keep District's table hosts informed of relevant information about the event, status of District's goals, etc.
5. Ensure that all table hosts are following established processes and timeline to clear and invite prospects to the event.
6. Make a Golden Eagle Event level contribution to the Friends of Scouting Campaign.
