A SCOUT IS REVERANT

These observances highlight the Scout Law point, "A Scout is Reverent," and provide an opportunity for Scouts to honor their faith, thank their chartered organizations, and share the Scouting program with their religious communities.

Scout Sunday, Scout Sabbath, and Scout Jumuah

Scout Sunday, Scout Sabbath, and Scout Jumuah are three meaningful observances within Scouting America. First recognized in 1914, these days celebrate the service and positive impact of both youth and adult members of the Scouting movement. Observing Scout Sunday, Scout Sabbath, and Scout Jumuah also provides an opportunity to introduce Scouting to members of faith communities who may be unfamiliar with the program.

For 2026, the following observance dates are recommended:

- Scout Sunday – February 8, 2026
- Scout Sabbath/Scout Shabbat – February 6 and 7, 2026
- Scout Jumuah – February 5 and 6, 2026
