Available Scholarships

Southern Illinois National Eagle Scout Association offers three merit scholarships that are to be awarded to three top Greater St. Louis Area Council Southern Illinois Eagle Scouts. Eagle Scouts from the following Districts may apply; Soaring Eagle, Cahokia Mounds, Kaskaskia, Black Gold, Illini, and Piasa Bird. The scholarship recipients will be announced your District Dinners held in Spring each year. \$1,000 scholarships are to be used toward tuition, books, supplies for coming school year at a college or accredited trade school. Students may be awarded only one Greater St. Louis Area Council Southern Illinois Eagle Scout Committee scholarship.

Procedures

- ▶ The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must complete the application **personally**.
- ▶ Enclose only the items requested in the requirements (no biographies, résumés, or supplemental lists of activities).
- ▶ Answer all questions on the application. (If necessary, use a separate piece of paper to answer the question.)
- ▶ Email the completed applications to: southernillnesa@gmail.com.
Southern Illinois NESA Scholarships Committee. Applications must be postmarked and received by the 31st of January.
- ▶ Please be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant. The selection committee will, in writing or email, notify those selected of its decision.
- ▶ Applying is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded. There is no appeal, and the decision of the scholarship committee is final.
- ▶ All applications submitted must be typed.
- ▶ **High School transcripts must be included with the application.**

Requirements

All applicants must:

1. Be an Eagle Scout in the Greater St. Louis Area Council and have received credentials from the national office.
2. Submitted applications must be postmarked by the 31st of January.
3. Be a graduating high school senior of the year you are applying, or an undergraduate college student no later than completion of the junior year. You may receive the scholarship **only once**. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
4. Provide one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer or professional Scout leader (please list Scouting title on the letter) who knows the applicant personally. This letter should attest to the general character of the applicant.
