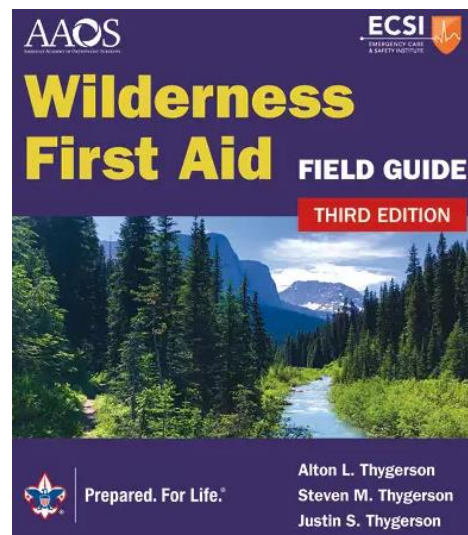


WILDERNESS FIRST AID TRAINING

For High Adventures...

Come join your Council Wilderness First Aid (WFA) Training Course to become trained/certified. This will equip you with knowledge and skills to manage injuries and illnesses requiring basic first aid in a remote environment, when EMS is several hours or more away.



This blended learning course meets Scouting America National High Adventure Base requirements. Philmont requires at least three WFA certified people in each crew. Northern Tier, Sea Base, and the Summit also have WFA certification requirements. Whether or not you plan for high adventure, this training applies to hiking and camping locations where it will take hours to receive EMS assistance.

You will complete the on-line learning portion on your own schedule, then complete the one-day in-person Skills Session (and receive the field guide pictured above) to complete certification. CPR/AED current certification is required to take our WFA course. You can become certified in conjunction with our WFA training. Go to <https://stlbsa.org/training/first-aid/>, go to CPR/AED, for information and registration. If you are CPR/AED current from another approved source, you do not need to complete our CPR course.
