Commonly Asked Questions:

When will we get our kit? Expect your kit to be ready 1-2 weeks after purchasing. We will email you when they are ready to be picked up or when we ship them out.

Is there a deadline to get a kit? Yes, orders must be made before December 31st.

What supplies are not included in the kit? We tried to provide you with any if the items needed for the activities but there are other commonly found household items not included in the kit. Other than that, we will provide all of the "odd" stuff!

Do I have to do all of the activities? Do what's best for your family! Is there an activity in here you cannot do? That is OKAY, there are lots of other options in this kit. Take note of what advancements are earned with each activity section. There is a full listing of the advancements in the back of the kit.
