Who can join Scouts BSA?

Girls ages 11-17 are invited to join the Scouts BSA program (called a “troop”) listed on this flyer. You may join at any age. No prior Scouting experience is necessary.

What will Scouts do?

Scouts BSA provides fun activities, new and challenging adventures, and leadership opportunities to help you become the best version of yourself. Whether it's camping, hiking, boating, shooting sports, or building remote controlled robots, the programs and outdoor adventures teach confidence, self-reliance, leadership, and character. These qualities make Scouts leaders in their classrooms, among their peers, and in their future careers. Scouting is the ultimate form of learning by doing. You will be introduced to countless hobbies, interests, sciences, and even future career choices along the way.

When do Scouts meet?

Scouts BSA troops are active and meeting while most other extracurricular activities are not. The program is year-round, but it allows for lots of flexibility. Scouts, leaders, and families can work together to choose a schedule that is convenient for everyone. Activities may be done in-person with small groups, online using programs like Zoom, or independently at home. We are prepared to deliver the Scouting programs in all permitted formats during the current pandemic.

What does it cost? We know families are facing new financial hardships. Assistance for registration fees and summer programs may be available. Fundraisers will also help provide for supplies and activities. The registration fee is \$66/year plus a one-time \$25 joining fee for new members. The \$25 joining fee is waived if you were ever previously registered in a BSA youth program. Any additional fees for activities, as well as fundraisers or payment options, will be discussed at the joining event on this flyer.
