Instructions

- 1. Merit Badge Counselors are required to be registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
 - If you are not currently registered, you must request and complete a BSA Adult Leader registration form. It may be obtained from any Council Service Center.
 - **No fee is required**. The Adult Leader Registration Form is not optional for first time applicants. A background check is part of this process.
- 2. A maximum of four merit badges is permitted per counselor.
- 3. You must be at least 18 years of age or older.
- 4. Include your business phone if you are able to take calls at that location, otherwise leave it blank.
- 5. Be specific in stating your qualifications. If you need more space, please use an extra sheet of paper.
- 6. The Merit Badge Counselor Directory is located on the STLBSA.org website. All merit badge counselors will be displayed on the website. Selecting to counsel for a particular unit only is not allowed. The only exception to this rule is for business partnerships that have agreed to work directly with the counsel regarding a special skill set.
- 7. Approval Process-
 - Complete the paper application and send to the council office or complete the online application.
 - Secure the District Advancement Chairman's and/or the District Executive's approval.
 - Update the Merit Badge Counselor Directory
 - Provide an email notification to the counselor.
- 8. Your Merit Badge Counselor number is the same as your membership number.
- 9. Annual renewal is required. You will be sent an email with the directions annually.
- Nova Counselor and Supernova Mentor positions are listed on the directory but have a separate application process. See the STEM page at <u>https://stlbsa.org/stem-unit/</u>. These will be included in the annual renewal process.
