CPR/AED Training

This training helps you recognize and respond to emergency situations and care for life-threatening respiratory or cardiac emergencies in adults (persons over 8 years of age). Learn to care for conscious and unconscious choking victims, perform CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

Youth Protection Training

The Greater St. Louis Area Council is offering live Youth Protection Training via Zoom on March 22. YPT is also offered online at my.scouting.org.

Youth Protection Training is required for all BSA registered volunteers and must be taken every two years. The BSA's Youth Protection Training covers strategies for personal safety and awareness for youth as well as adults.

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)

NYLT is an amazing six-day, team-building, skills learning week that every Scout should experience. This unique course delivers training in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids, which allows participants to understand and employ the leadership skills much faster.
