

2021 Last Scouts Standing Leaders Guide

April 16-18, 2021 - Pine Ridge Scout Camp



What - The toughest and most rewarding thing you will ever do at a scout campout!

This is a multi-day skills and endurance backpacking race with four person teams and multiple checkpoint challenges, scored by overall time. Electronic time clock entry at beginning and end of day. Two hour time limits at challenge sites. Some challenges are scored, incrementally reducing your overall time.

Register as a four person team or individually. Individuals will be placed into a team. Teams will be hiking over 20 miles during the course. It is recommended that participants know their gear and how to pack and carry it before the event. Practice and build endurance with your pack! At LSS, you will be tested physically and mentally. Participants should have good map reading skills. GPS receivers or Mobile GPS Apps on a smartphone would be helpful too.

Cost -

- \$60 participants (An LSS t-shirt, patch, and lunch Sunday is included with the registration.)
- \$40 staff (An LSS t-shirt, patch, Saturday and Sunday meals included with the registration.)

Team age groups - limit of 10 teams

- 14 - 17yrs. Scouts MUST be 14 by the beginning of the event.
- 18yrs. and up, meaning any registered adult may participate.

Medical

There will be medical and first responders in the area. Scouts should carry any prescriptions with them during this event. Please contact J.R. Owens if you have special needs regarding prescriptions.

Camping & water

Friday night LSS participants will camp at Pine Ridge Scout Camp. Participants need to have their own tents. Saturday night the LSS groups will be camping at sub camp "B", and building shelters. **Water will be provided at each station and campsite.**

Awards

There will be awards and prizes for the winning team from each age category, so be prepared and do your best!

Schedule



Friday

- 5:00-7:00pm - Check-in at Pine Ridge Scout Camp. Parts A & B of the health form are required, Part C is recommended. Food is on your own. All of the team's gear, as well as their food for Saturday and Sunday morning must be packed with them at all times. Lunch will be provided upon return to camp Sunday.
- 07:30pm - Welcome ceremony at parade grounds.
- 08:00pm - Last Scouts Standing team meeting.
- 11:00pm - Turn in - lights out. Camping Friday night is to be in individual tents. Bring your own and plan to pack it up first thing Saturday. Tents will be stored at camp until your departure on Sunday.

Saturday

- ???am - Teams will be leaving camp EARLY in the morning and will not return to camp until Sunday.
- ???pm - Teams will be on course all day for challenges and meals. Water will be at challenge sites.
- ???pm - Teams will be camping off-site at sub camp "B", and building shelters. Staff and water will be present along the route and at sub camp "B".
