Initial Weekend Training Schedule and Information

Wednesday evening session: 7pm at Beaumont (Emerson Center, downstairs in Theatre Room): You will get trained on knots, receive a detailed equipment list, and training about equipment and what to bring for the weekend training and camping at S Bar F.

Saturday morning: Meet at Nim's Lake Overlook parking lot at S Bar F Scout Ranch at approximately 7:30am. We hike out of the parking lot at 8am sharp – don't be late, we leave at 8am with or without you.

Sunday: We will finish the training about 5pm.
