# CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and First Aid Training

This is the training that is required for, but usually not included with, BSA Lifeguard (requirement #6) training. So this is a good idea if you are planning on earning BSA Lifeguard this summer at camp. Registration priority will be given to those who will be working on BSA Lifeguard.

The course uses the blended learning method. This combines online sessions done at your convenience with the scheduled hands-on in-classroom skills session.

You will have from when you register to the classroom skills session to complete the 4 hr online components. The in-person skills session is Saturday, May 7 from 9am-2pm.



In order to attend the in-person skills session, students must pass the assessment at the end of the online session and print a copy of their online completion certification to submit to the instructor at the in-person session.

- American Red Cross First Aid
- American Red Cross CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and Health Care Providers
