- * Due to COVID-19, **Preregistration is REQUIRED.** Unit Registration must be submitted no later than Friday, May 27th. Please do not wait to the last moment to register. We cannot assign units to Cemeteries until we have a minimum of commitments to enable us to cover all locations. Your early registration will enable us to transmit Cemetery assignments earlier. If we do not hear from you early, there is a possibility we will be unable to release Cemetery assignments before Friday Evening, May 27th. Absolute Deadline for Unit Registration is Friday, May 27th, 11:59pm
- * Flag Pickup will be on Saturday, May 28th at United Hebrew Congregation from 1:00pm - 3:00pm. Those units that will be asked to pickup the Flags and Unit Packets for each Cemetery will be notified. Please be sure to tell us if your unit is willing to pick up flags and packets for your cemetery. We will also provide each unit with contact information for the other units working your cemetery. This will enable all units to coordinate your arrival.
- * Units should plan on arriving at your Cemetery NOT before 9:00am on Sunday, May 29th.
- * For the Safety of all, we ask that everyone wear a Mask and maintain 6' Social Distance when placing the Flags. Scouts should self-check on Sunday morning before departure for a temperature and/or flu like symptoms. Two youth from different families can travel together if the parents of both families approve and youth maintain separation within the vehicle.
