## Camp Rules and Regulations

Camp Code	The Scout Oath, Law and Outdoor Code.
Roster	The troop roster, enclosed with this packet, will be filled out and turned into HQ upon registration. Make additional copies if needed. Patrols should have 5 to 9 people. (You may bring your own roster from your Troops database.)
Generators	Generators will be permitted, but they must be turned off between 10:30pm and 7:30am.
Cooking Fuels supervision.	All flammable liquids must be under adult control and
Pressurized Fuels	All pressurized fuels must be locked away safely when not in use. Refer to the "Guide to Safe Scouting" and your pressurized fuel training.
Use of Water	Water sources are only for filling containers. They are not to be used for personal hygiene, washing or rinsing dishes, or washing clothes.
Ground Fires	Ground fires will not be permitted. You must use a fire pit if you are going to have campfires.
Tent Ditching	Proper pitching avoids 'ditching'. Digging ditches around tents is prohibited.
Garbage	A dumpster will be provided for trash. Do not bury garbage.
Tobacco	No person under the age of 18 is permitted to use or possess tobacco products. Adults are encouraged to refrain from using tobacco products but if they do, use away from all youth & event areas. Violators will be asked to leave.
Alcohol and Drugs	Alcoholic beverages & non-medically prescribed drugs are not allowed on Council property or at Council activities. Violators will be asked to leave.
Sheath Knives	Sheath knives are not permitted.
Fireworks & Firearms	Fireworks & Firearms are not permitted. Violators will be asked to leave.
Early Arrivals	Those persons who are not on staff that arrive prior to 4:30pm Friday will be asked to not set up.
School vs. Scouts	All Scouts should complete their school schedules before departing for the Camporee.

### **Be Prepared! - Requirement 2A**

### **Emergency Kit Construction - Requirement 2c**

Learn how to construct a survival safety kit, for survival scenarios.

### **Meet the Pro's - Requirement 6 & 8**

Quickly setup an A frame tent, and pack and paddle tent, to survive the night.

### **SOS - Requirement 4**

Use your expert memory skills to quickly remember what items you need to survive and how to signal to save yourself!

### **A frame Race - Requirement 5**

Create an A frame carrying device to safely carry the wounded station director to where they can be treated.

### **This is not a Test! - Requirement 7**

Show your skills and mobilize your patrol to help in this simulated emergency.

### **Escape Room - Requirement 9**

Learn how to make an emergency escape plan, then race against your fellow scouts to escape a burning building obstacle course.

### **We are Prepared! Requirement 2B & 3**

Work your way through 10 emergency situations and see how your Troop scores on the Emergency Preparedness Scale

### **Cookie Cook Off**

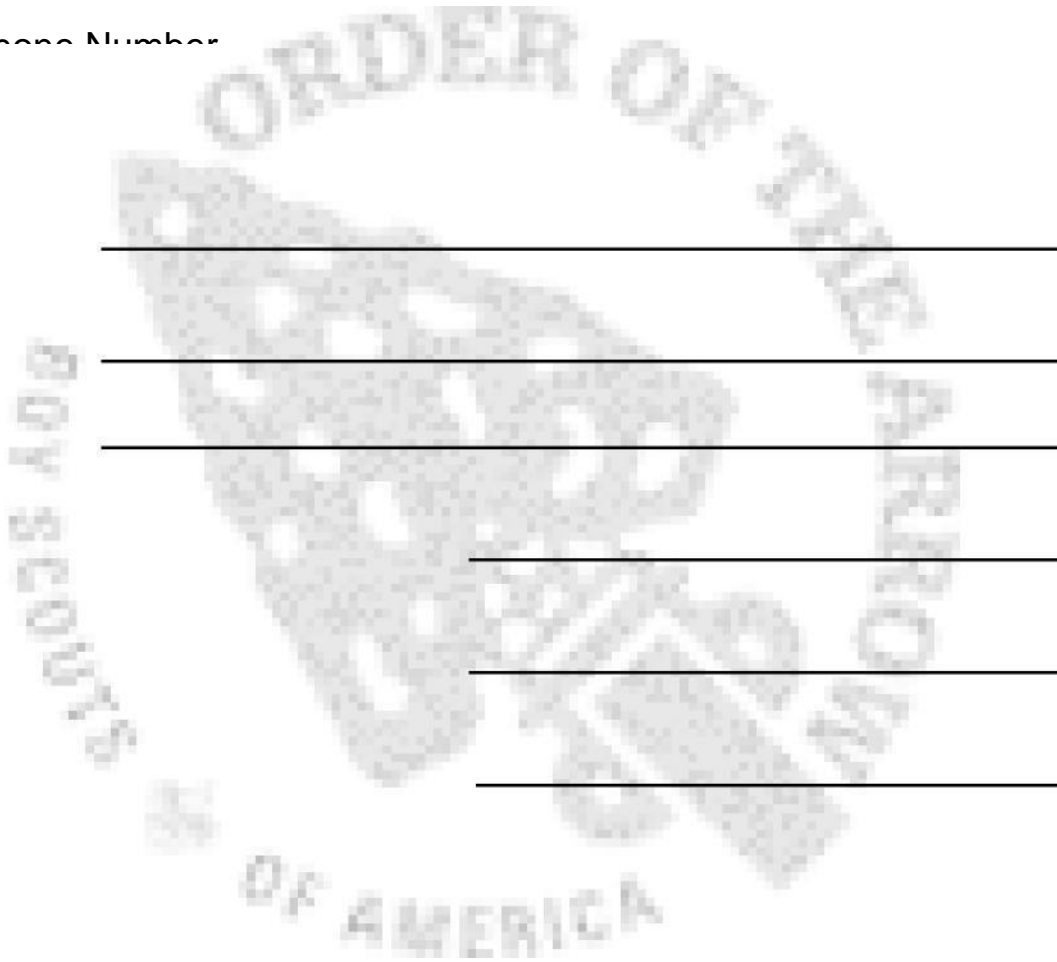
