- * Preregistration is still required for all units. Unit registration must be submitted no later than Friday, May 26th. Please do not wait to the last moment to register. We cannot assign units to cemeteries until we have a minimum number of commitments to cover all locations. Your early registration will help us to release cemetery assignments at the earliest date possible. **Deadline for unit registration is Friday, May 26, 7:00 pm.**
- * When registering, please tell us if someone from your unit can be available to pick up flags for your cemetery on Saturday afternoon, May 27, between 1:00pm to 3:00pm at United Hebrew Congregation, located at 13788 Conway Road (Conway just west of Hwy. 141). Packets for all units working your cemetery will be given to the individual picking up your flags.
- * Units should plan on arriving at your cemetery **NOT** before 9:00am on Sunday, May 28th.
- * While COVID-19 is less a factor, masking and social distancing should be at the discretion of each family. Out of consideration for your fellow scout, anyone with symptoms should not be in attendance.
- * Last year's Good Turn was recognized by Missouri's Attorney General for service to our community.
